FOR YOUR SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

- **No early queuing allowed.** Customers are advised to allow sufficient time to travel to the event and pass-through security checks.
- Arrive no earlier than necessary - **early customers will be turned away** from the event.
- Avoid queuing nearby to prevent disruption to residents. Plan to be inside the venue 30 minutes before the show starts.
- Charge your phone and bring battery packs with you - you'll need battery to access your tickets!
- For health and safety, **camping or collapsible chairs are not allowed** and will be confiscated at the Event Entrances. **CONFISCATED ITEMS WILL NOT BE RETURNED.**
- This is a **standing only venue.** Check the forecast and dress accordingly for Irish weather - think boots or runners, layers, raincoats/ponchos and sun cream but remember, **no umbrellas.**
- **Show your ticket at the ticket check** outside the venue for inspection.
- **Strict security checks** will be in operation. Everyone will be subject to a search permissible under law, per [Purchase Policy](#). It is a condition of entry, to protect everyone's safety. Additional searches may take place once inside the venue.
- Customers are especially **advised not to bring large bags/backpacks** as they may experience delays or be refused entry. There will be **no storage facilities** on site. Any items left at entrances/in surrounding areas will be removed and disposed of accordingly.
- Bags larger than A4, signs/flags bigger than A3, flag poles, glass or cans, umbrellas, alcohol, e-scooters/e-bikes, disposable vapes, flares, professional cameras and audio recording equipment will not be permitted, see the **full list of prohibited items on [Prohibited Items](#)**. - **All venue bars will be cashless.** You can use debit/credit cards or apps on your phone, such as Google Pay and Apple Pay. **Food vendors will take cash and card payments.**
- **NO ALCOHOL or DRINKS** are permitted to be brought into the venue with the exception of water and soft drinks in sealed plastic bottles up to 500ml. Empty non-glass reusable bottles are permitted into the venue. There are several drinking water points throughout the concert site.
- **Obey the stewards and Gardaí** and instructions given over the public address for your own safety.
- **Phone signal may be limited** during the event. Agree a meeting point with your group in case you get separated or your phone battery runs out. There are meeting points located in the Main Arena inside the Grange Road Arena Entrance and in Field 2 near Emergency Exit E.
- There is **no re-admission** to the concerts. If you leave, there is **no re-entry**.

NEED HELP ON THE DAY?

Look out for our offsite stewarding volunteers in the areas surrounding Marlay Park. They will be wearing a **Pink Hi-Vis** and will be able to guide you the concert entrances.

CHARITIES & ORGANISATIONS

Safe Gigs Ireland will be on site to promote their petition calling for standalone legislation for spiking in Ireland.

Shine will be present to campaign for an open and positive attitude towards mental health.

ISPCD will be onsite with child registration forms for parents and guardians to complete in case a child becomes separated during the event.

Women's Aid is the national domestic violence service in Ireland. They will be running the #TooIntoYou campaign, to teach young people, in particular young women, about intimate relationship abuse (All shows excluding The Cure & Florence + The Machine).

The We-Consent campaign will be promoted on-site, bringing a positive, conversational approach to consent.

Vision Ireland will be operating a pop-up shop selling vintage clothing.



TRANSPORT

Plan and book your return travel arrangements in advance using official NTA licensed transport providers. Download Evtz App to find full listing of independent regional coach services available to book.

There is Limited Event Car Parking available. This MUST be pre booked via Evtz App.

Allow yourself at least an additional 3 hours travel time to and from the venue. As traffic and parking delays are inevitable, you are encouraged to walk, cycle or use event bus services.

Public and private transport services are managed and operated under licence by the National Transport Authority (NTA).

Promoters do not operate transport to/from venue. This is a matter for customers to arrange in advance. More information on transport can be found via the Evtz App.

Do NOT park illegally or in residential areas. Use Event Bus Services where possible.

It's a quick and easy safety check before you head home.

DESIGNATED END OF CONCERT PICK-UP AREA

Nutgrove Shopping Centre will be the designated **end of concert pick up only** area for all Marlay Park Concerts.

There are 2 event entrances. Grange Road is for pedestrians and College Road is for Pre-Booked Parking and Event Transportation. Interactive maps available via the Evtz App.

TICKETING

Download your tickets to your phone ahead of the event - don't wait until the day. **Screenshots will not work** as barcodes are live and updating regularly. Ticketmaster have a secure system which includes moving barcodes to reduce ticket touting. Please use the Ticketmaster 'transfer' option if you are arriving separately to your group. The ticket transfer window typically opens 2 weeks before the event takes place.

AGE POLICY

ALL SHOWS (EXCL. CALVIN HARRIS)

Under 16's MUST be accompanied at all times by a Parent/Guardian over 25, who takes full responsibility and remains with them throughout the event.

Strict age monitoring will be in place. **Unaccompanied under 16's will be refused entry without refund.** The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission without refund to anyone who fails to comply.

Recommended no under 5's. All attendees must have a ticket.

CALVIN HARRIS

Under 17s will not be permitted to attend Calvin Harris. Attendees will be asked for identification on arrival.

There is a strict Challenge 21 policy on site and only a passport, drivers licence, or Garda Age Card will be accepted for the purchase of alcohol and nicotine products.
